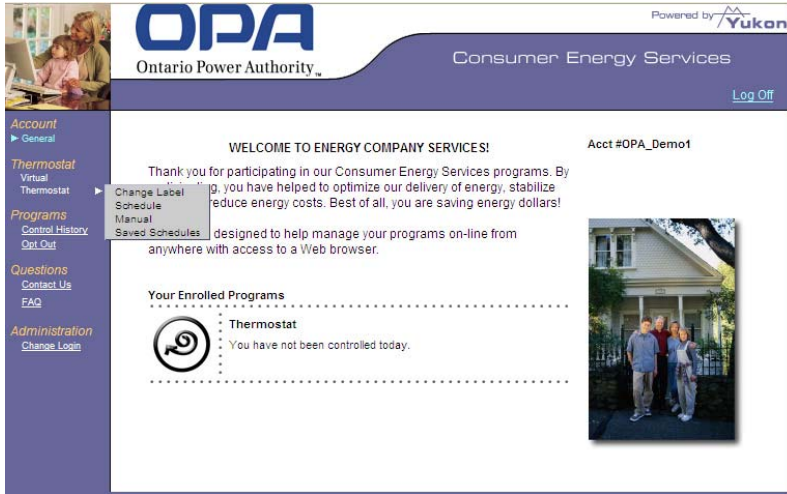


# **Cannon ExpressStat Web Interface**

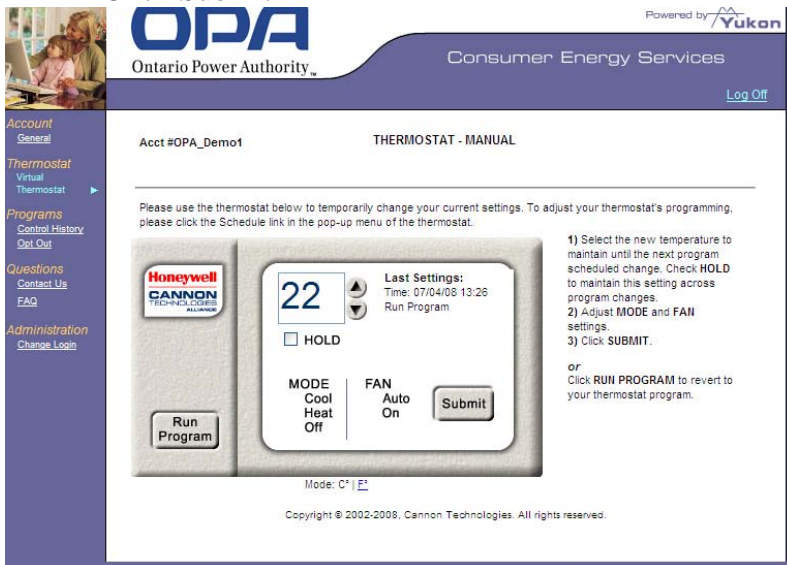
## Cannon ExpressStat Web Interface

To Manually Adjust Thermostat:

- Mouse over virtual thermostat on left menu bar
- Click Manual

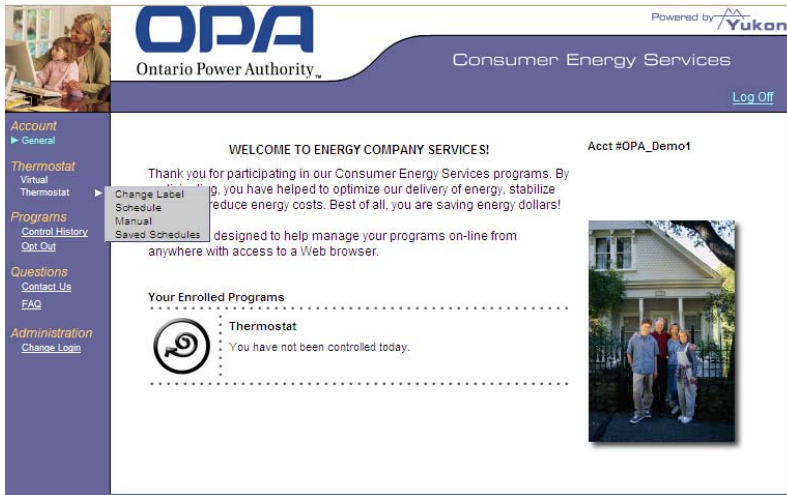


- Select Mode
- Select Fan
- Change desired temperature
- Click Hold
- Click Submit

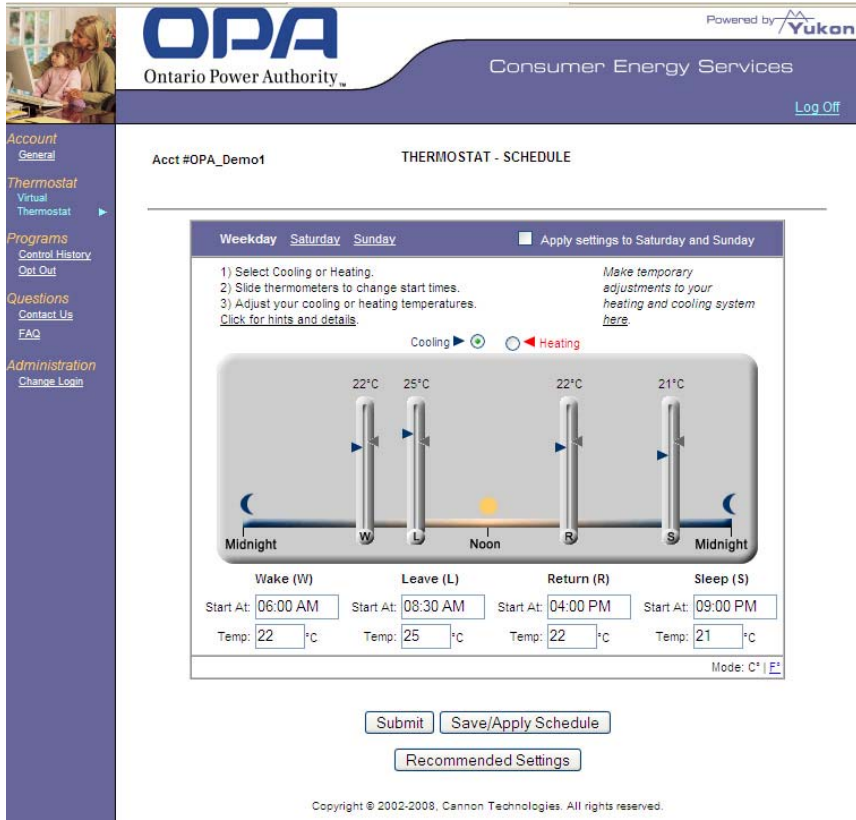


To Program a Schedule:

- Mouse over virtual thermostat on left menu bar
- Click Schedule

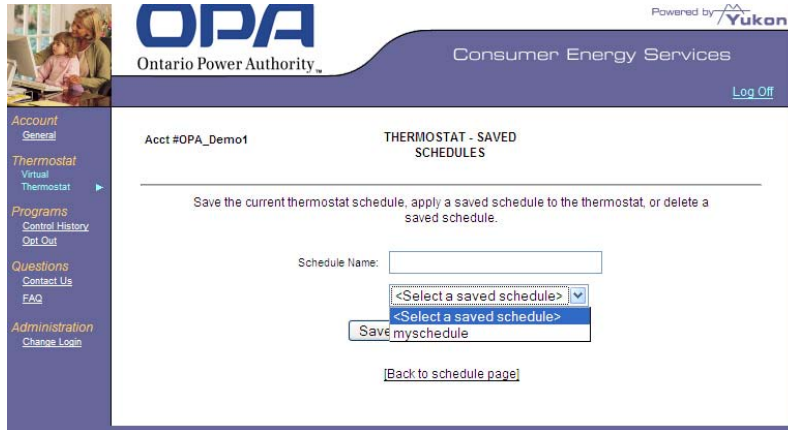


- Select which day (weekday, Saturday, Sunday) is to be effected by the schedule
- Select Cooling or Heating
- Adjust bar W/L/R/S (left and right) for start time of period control
- Adjust arrows on bars (up and down) for desired temperature during period of control (blue for cooling, red for heating)
- Click Save/Apply Schedule
- Enter a Name for the Schedule



To Activate a Programmed Schedule:

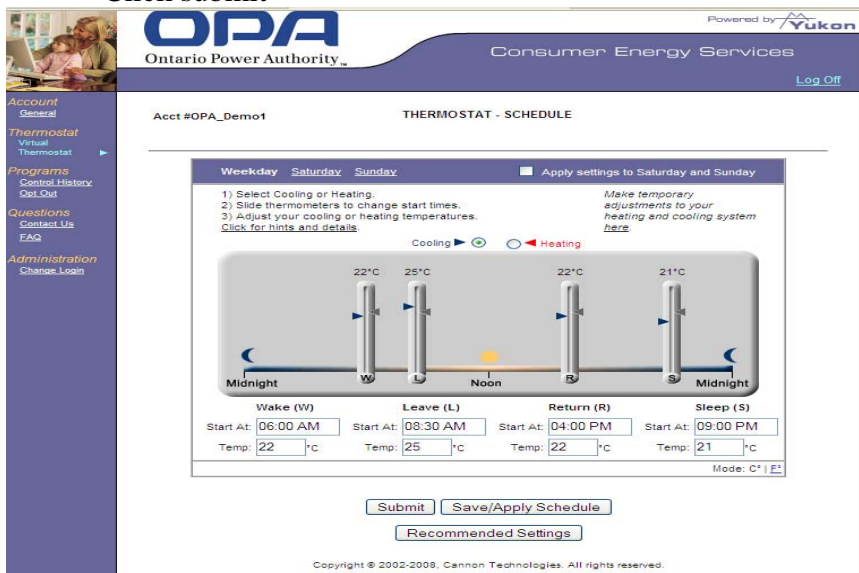
- Mouse over virtual thermostat on left menu bar (refer to above pictures)
- Click Saved Schedules



- Select desired schedule from drop down menu
- Click apply



- Make changes if desired (saved settings will be represented in schedule screen)
- Click submit



To 'Opt Out' of being controlled for a specified period (no longer than 2 full days):

- Click Opt Out on left menu bar
